



Academic Project Scholarships in Madrid-Spain for Chinese Technical Students

Madrid— August 15, 2011

The Technical University of Madrid (UPM, *Universidad Politecnica de Madrid*) is offering up to thirty scholarships for students from leading Chinese Technical Universities (partners of UPM) to conduct graduate or undergraduate engineering projects in the Technical University of Madrid. These projects shall receive academic credit in the Chinese home university.

Each scholarship awarded will consist of six thousand euros to cover cost of air fare as well as living expenses in Madrid for a period of six months. Students admitted to this program will be exempt from tuition fees at UPM and provided free medical and accidents insurance for the period of the scholarship.

Applications shall arrive no later than October 15, 2011 and include:

1. A one page curriculum vitae
2. Statement of purpose clearly indicating preferred technical areas of work, special expertise or experience in these areas, and preferred periods of time to develop the project at UPM.
3. Two letters of recommendation from university professors
4. Proof (by any internationally recognized test or by interview) of knowledge of the English language (minimum level required equivalent to TOEFL 80(IB)/213(CB)/550(PB)). CET is not acceptable
5. Original transcript of records
6. Translation to English of the transcript of records, signed and sealed by the student's home University

All applications will be answered by December 10, 2011.
